Causes:

- Technology
- Psychology

Solution: resist temptation to write it off as a lack of common sense

- 1. Recognize problem as one of technology & psychology
- 2. Develop sound social media policy
- 3. Provide training for all members
 - -Initial
 - -Ongoing
